Completion of the Rickreall Creek Trail


The revenue generated from the sale of the bricks will go to the Park Trust Fund to help finance the completion of the Rickreall Creek Trail and a substantial portion will go to local non-profit organizations.



- The purchaser of the brick can choose to have a portion of the proceeds go to a local non-profit organization* or choose to have all of the proceeds go to the Park Trust Fund.
- For every brick purchased \$50 will go towards finishing the park trail. Another \$50 will go to a non-profit organization* of the purchaser's choice. If a symbol is added, an additional \$25.00 will go to the same non-profit organization generating a \$75 contribution.



Community Working Together

The City of Dallas Park and Recreation Board has implemented the engraved brick/paver project not only to help fund the completion of the Rickreall Creek Trail, but to support our local non-profit organizations and provide our citizens the opportunity to personalize the trail by marking it in a beautiful and lasting way.

Purchase a brick for yourself or someone else

The Bricks cost \$150 each, **all of which is tax deductible**. They can be engraved with your name, a special message, as a memorial, or donated anonymously.

Bricks will be placed at the Trail Heads

The Bricks will be placed at the trailhead entrances of the Rickreall Creek Trail throughout the City of Dallas in an effort to beautify the City and generate revenue for the Park Trust Fund and other local Dallas area non-profit organizations. Orders will be placed to the manufacturer in batches of 10 and installation will take place once the bricks are received and weather permitting. Once your brick has been installed, you will be notified of the exact placement location.

Engraving

There is no additional charge for engraving. Bricks can be engraved with up to four lines with 21 characters per line. (The recommended outline is three lines with 18 characters per line.)

Our Supplier offers a lifetime guarantee of the materials and the engraving.



Symbols and Custom Logos

- To make your brick stand out amongst the others, there are over 200 symbols that can be engraved on your brick for a fee of \$25.00 (all of which goes to the non-profit of your choice).
- Custom logos can also be added to your brick for a one time set-up of \$100. Once the first brick has been engraved, your logo will be added to our symbols list and each additional use will cost \$25.00, all of which will go to the non-profit of the purchasers choice.

2. Engraving

There is no additional charge for engraving. Bricks can be engraved with up to four lines with 21 characters per line. (The recommended is three lines with 18 characters per line.)

3. Symbols and Logos

There are over 200 symbols to choose from including football helmets, library books, and musical notes (for a complete list of examples, please visit the website at www.dallasor.gov/symbols). These can be added for an additional fee of \$25.00. Custom logos such as corporate, local business or non-profit organizations with camera ready artwork can be added for a one time set-up fee, please contact City of Dallas staff at 503.831.3502 for details.
