We have seen multiple reports and stories on social media referring to the incident that occurred in the Safeway parking lot tonight. Around 6 o'clock, Dallas Police and the Polk County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of a female yelling she was going to kill someone in the Safeway parking lot. While both agencies were in route, she reportedly began punching herself and then quickly thereafter became physical with a male she was with. Upon arrival, the female and male were separated and as he was explaining what had happened to officers, the female ran up from the other side of the parking lot, once again yelling. Officers attempted to calm her down but she continued to yell and become aggressive by pushing Dallas officers and kicking a Polk County Deputy. She was eventually detained and taken to the West Valley Hospital for evaluation before being lodged at Polk County Jail for Attempted Assault on Public Safety Officer, Resisting Arrest, Harassment, and Disorderly Conduct in the Second Degree.
